# Evaluation

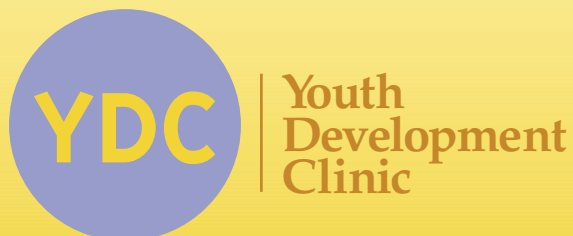
Psychological and educational assessment for all kinds of emotional and academic problems.

# Our specialized services include:

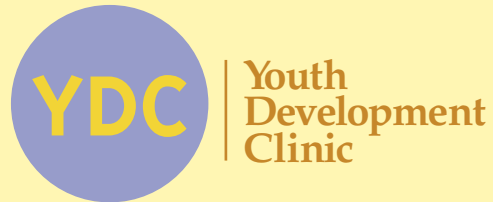
- Compliance for Autism education and programs in school districts

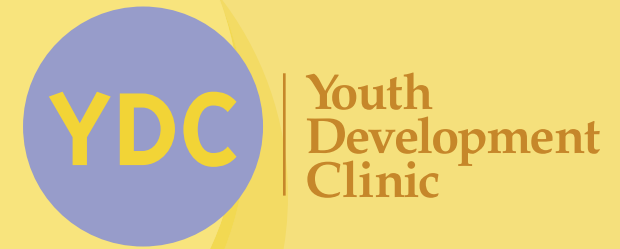
# How YDC can help you and your students
